- Trust- ability to believe in those around you
 - co-workers, boss
- Patience- ability to block out annoyance when confronted with delay
 - get job done, no matter how long
- Respect- to show regard or consideration for
 - authoritative positions, co workers
- Cooperation- to work in conjunction with
 - working with team

TEAMWORK

- Organization- the process of being structured
 - Having what you want where you need
- Tension- another word for stress
 - How do you work under pressure
- Interaction- working with others
 - Can you handle group work
- Control- to exercise restraint over your emotions/actions
 - When faced with difficulty

TEAMWORK

- Persuasion- your ability to influence others
 - Can you be the leader, will others listen?
- Disposition- keeping your cool and cooling others
 - Can others expect you to react to change positively and effectively
- Responsibility- doing what you're supposed to do, when you're supposed to do it
 - Can others count on you?
- Perseverance- being persistent and overcoming
 - Get through the tough times

TEAMWORK

- Determination- willingness to do what you need to do to get the job done
 - Finish!
- Understanding- listening and realizing others behaviors and why they might feel that way
 - Can you work with the team?
- Listening- more than just “hearing”, understanding what people say/do and why
 - Can others trust you to be an ear?
